2. Course Level Learning Outcomes (COs):

A. CORE COURSES

a. Core Courses-1 & 2: Western Philosophy 1 & 11

- Students learn the genesis of Western Philosophy and acquaint themselves with basic philosophical ideas concerning categories of thought, reality, knowledge and truth
- Students will be acquainted with Modern Western Philosophers and gain foundational knowledge of philosophical problems

b. Core Courses -3 & 4: Indian Philosophy 1 & 11

- Students will be acquainted with the basic problems of Metaphysics and Epistemology in Classical Indian Philosophy

c. Core Course-5: Ethics-Western and Indian

- Students learn about ethical theories and ideas of morality found in both Western and Indian traditions

d. Core Course- 6: Philosophy of Religion

- Students acquaint themselves with the problems and concepts from the perspective of the Major World religions as well as the Naga Tribal Religion

e. Core Course- 7 & 10 : Logic -1 & 11

- Students learn the basics of Deductive Traditional Logic
- Students are equipped with reasoning and testing them in Modern Symbolic Logic

f. Core Course-8: Social and Political Philosophy

- Students will be acquainted with Social and Political thoughts and ideals

g. Core Course-9: Philosophy of Mind

- Learners will gain insight into the nature and problem of mind and consciousness from both the Western and Indian perspectives

h. Core Course-11: Philosophy of Culture

- Students obtain theoretical clarity regarding the concept of culture in general and of the traditional Naga way of life in particular

i. Core Course-12: Existentialism and Phenomenology

- Students are acquainted with the various strands of contemporary thought

j. Core Course-13: Applied Ethics

- Appreciation is developed regarding the human moral choices and responsibilities

k. Core Course-14: Analytic Philosophy

- A scientific attitude is promoted in the area of logic, language and reality

B. GENERIC ELECTIVE COURSES

a. GE-1: Western Philosophy 1

- Students learn the genesis of Western Philosophy and acquaint themselves with basic philosophical ideas concerning categories of thought, reality, knowledge and truth

b. GE-2: Indian Philosophy 1

- New areas of research and original thinking enhanced by doing work on topic of own choice


D. SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES
