28 responses

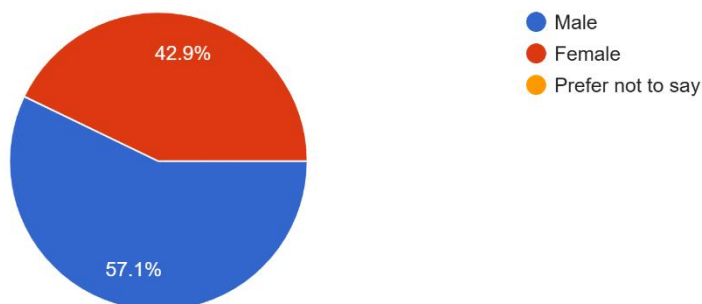


Figure 1: Gender equality of survey participants

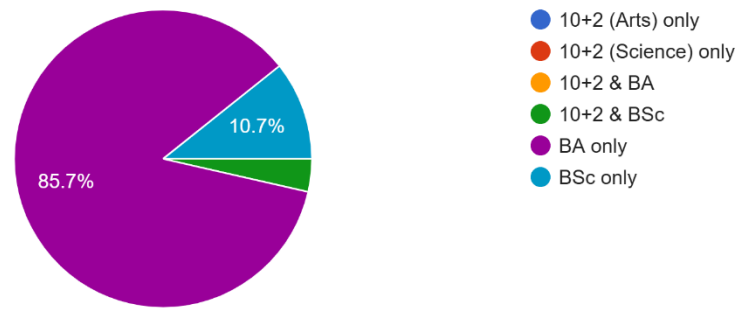


Figure 2: Courses studied in the college by the respondents

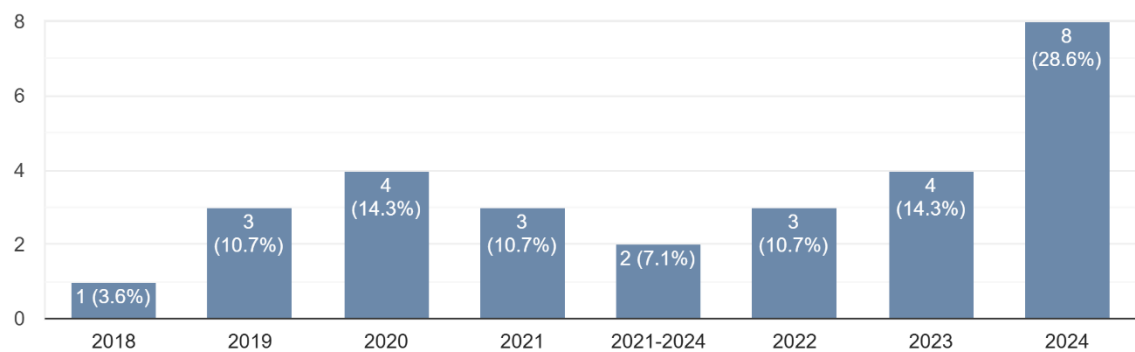


Figure 3: Passing year batches of the participants

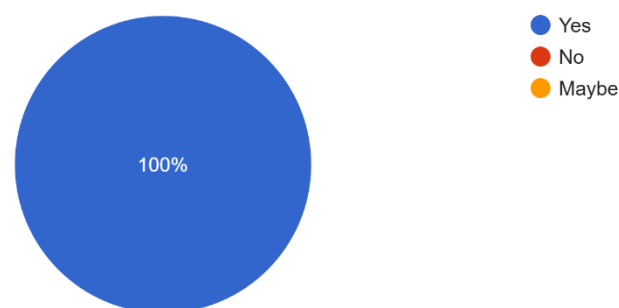


Figure 4: Do you feel proud to be associated with FAC as an alumnus/alumna?

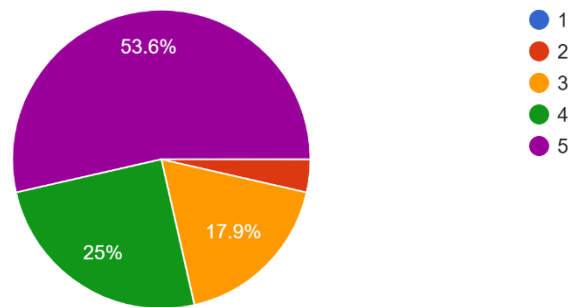


Figure 5: How would you rate your overall experience in the College? Please select your ratings on the scale 1 to 5.

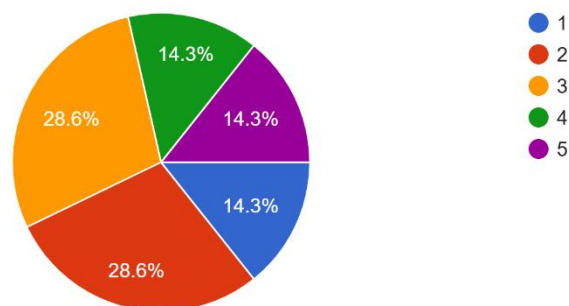


Figure 6: Did you stay in college hostel? If so, how do you rate the hostel facilities? Higher the score better the perception / experience.

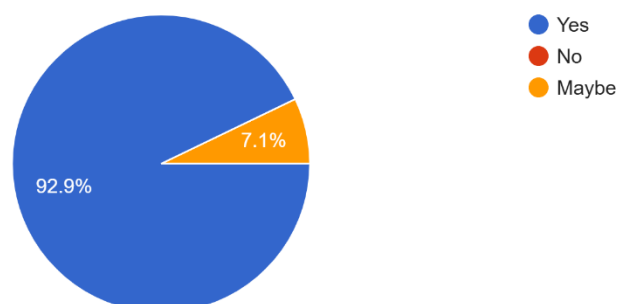


Figure 7: Will you recommend your relative/friends to enrol at FAC?

14. Please rate the following areas of the College as per your opinion

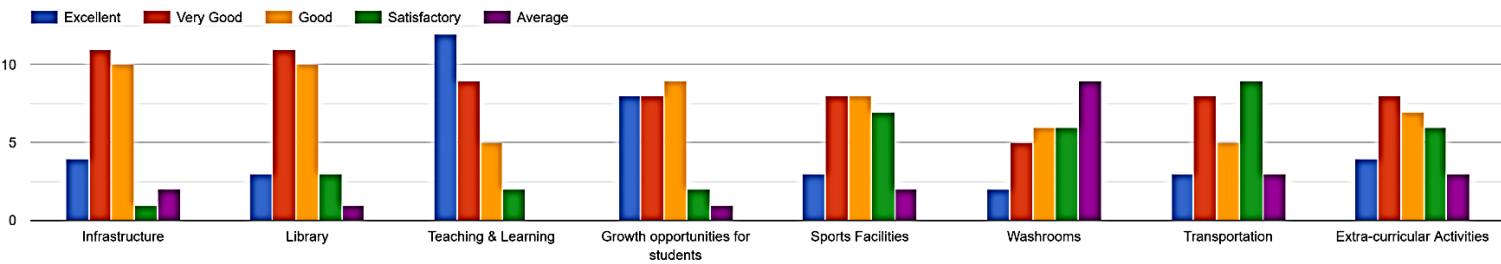


Figure 8: Please rate the following areas of the College as per your opinion.

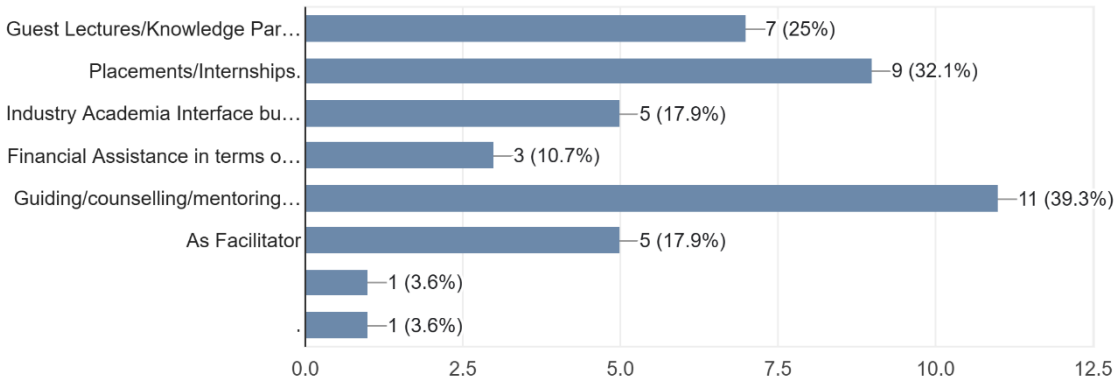
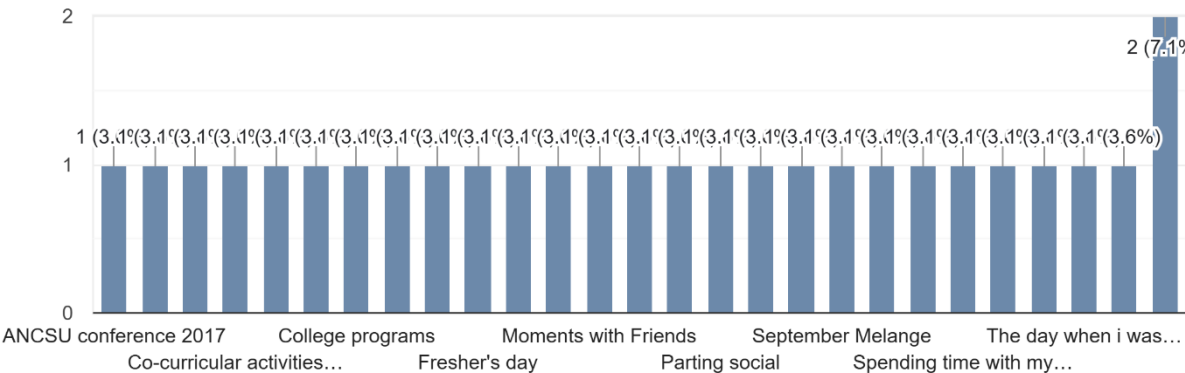


Figure 9: How would you like to contribute towards the development of the College?

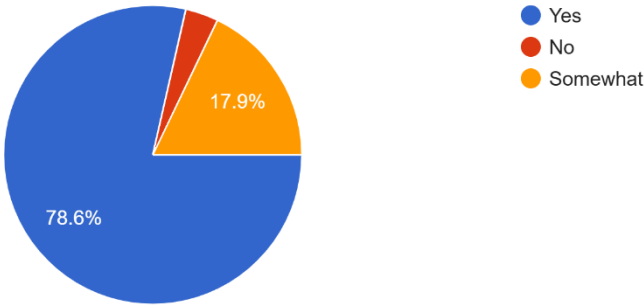
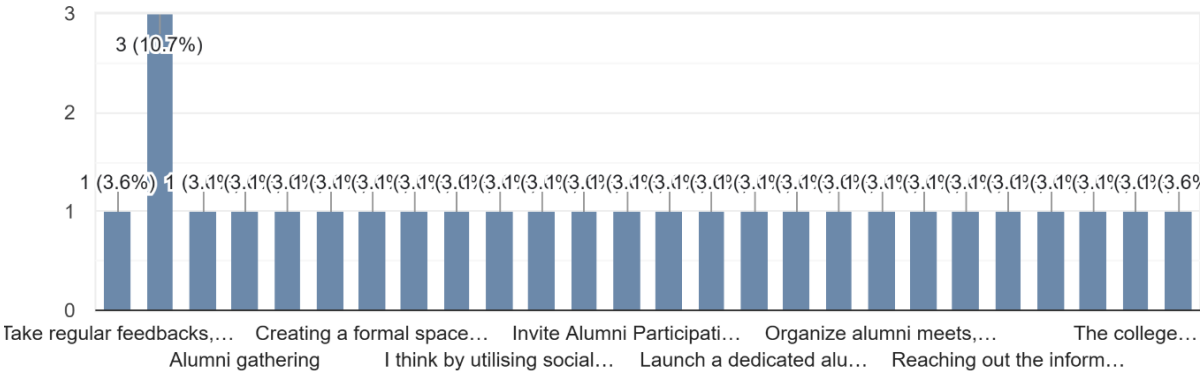


Figure 10: Are you satisfied with the efforts taken by the College to connect with its Alumni?

Some suggestions by alumni for improvement of college:

- Understanding the weak student and give them personal guidance.
- Offers strong support in finding jobs, internship, it includes interview practices
- Introducing more career guidance sessions and placement support could really benefit students in preparing for life after graduation.
- Improve the laboratories facility. Upgrade laboratories and computer labs with modern equipment.
- Provide Wi-Fi connectivity throughout the campus.
- Offer career counseling, soft skills training, and mock interview sessions.
- Organize annual alumni meets and honor notable contributions
- Improve library facilities with access to more digital resources and journals.
- There is a common negative denominator in all government colleges which is low grading and grade disparity, our college is no exception. In this day and age where there is a plethora of private colleges Fazlians with their grades cannot hope to compete especially since private colleges have more flexible grading policies. Ergo encouraging promising students by scoring them well would greatly help them in their career especially since academic weightage is an integral part of the screening process in higher education recruitment. The disparity between the CGPA of Fazlians and other colleges is concerning.
- Teachers providing materials and career counselling especially for aspirants that want a career in higher education and academia would greatly arm the students with knowledge that will give them a leg up in their career.
- Lastly I would urge the teachers to go out of their ways to be more interactive with the students, a hands-on approach would make all the difference. "
- The college could do with a sound PA system in the auditorium and halls and also a good set of musical instruments.
- The college can enhance its sports and music facilities by introducing dedicated music courses. Establishing a college choir would be a great initiative, as FAC has no shortage of musical talent. Investing in musical equipment and instruments would further strengthen the college's music program.
- In terms of sports, the existing facilities are limited and could be expanded to offer a wider range of activities and better infrastructure for students"
- Improve infrastructure, better connection with students and teachers and more opportunities

- Upgrading playground and smart technology for teaching
- Everything was good for me but if I have to leave a suggestion for improvement it will be the toilet. Need to construct some more.
- Developing partnership for internship and research and fostering strong relationships with graduates
- Promote research and innovation among students.
