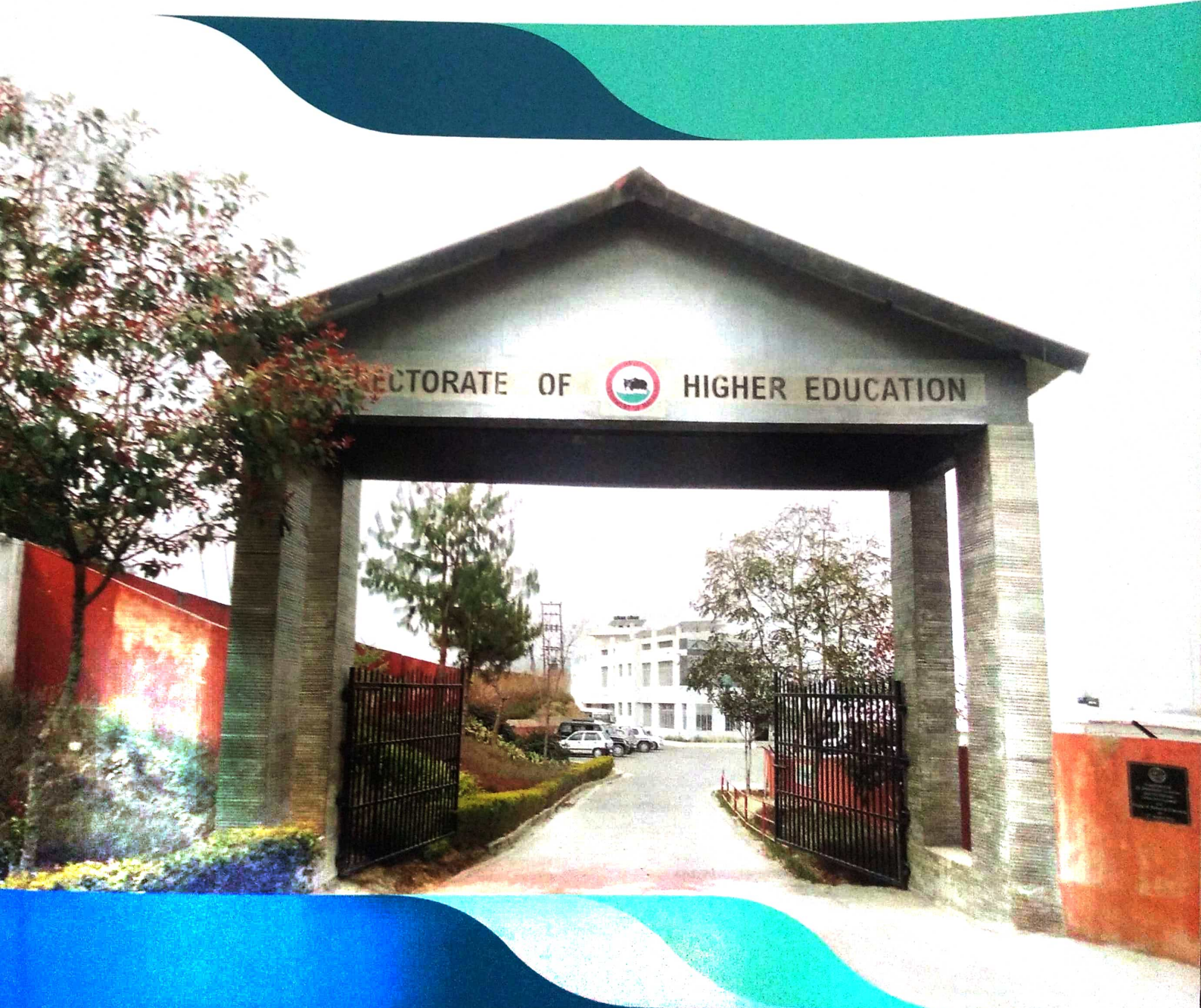

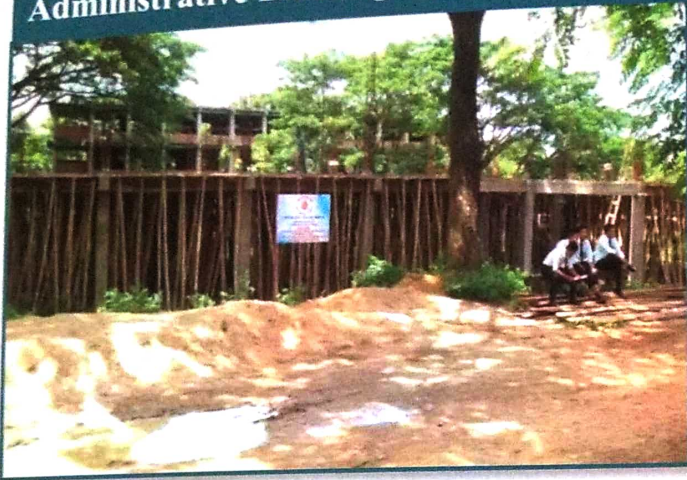

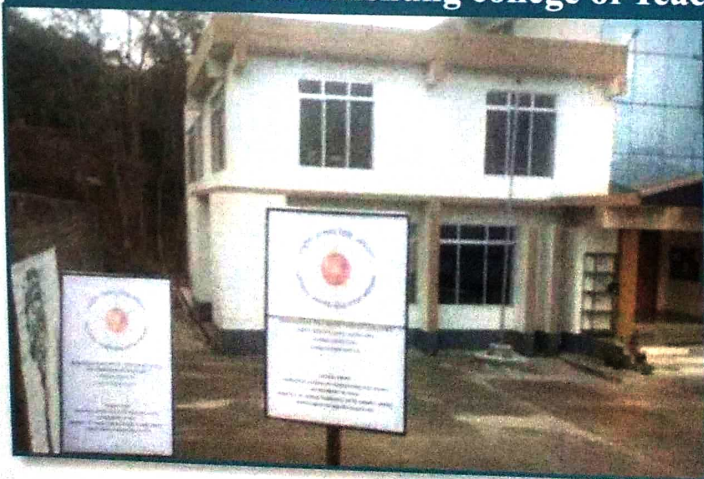

ii) FAZLALI COLLEGE, MOKOKCHUNG



Fazl Ali College was established in 1959 as an evening college in the premises of the then Government High School (presently the Mayangnokcha Government Higher Secondary School) with 43 students and 3 teachers. Named after the then Governor of undivided Assam, Shri Syed Fazl Ali, the college has since then grown from strength to strength. In 1962, the college shifted its premises to the present Old Town Hall.

The College was then taken over by the Government in 1963 (with retrospective effect from 1962) and in 1971, it shifted to the present campus near Chuchuyimpang Village. Science stream was added in 1983 offering the PU (Sc) course and it was upgraded to BSc level in 1999. The



College went for NAAC accreditation in 2009 and was graded B. It went for the second cycle of accreditation in 2015 and was awarded B.

The college has 16 academic Departments (English, Philosophy, Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, Education, Functional English, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Computer Science and Ao (MIL) with 84 teaching staff, 96 non-teaching staff and 722 Arts and 216 Science students (total 938 students) enrolled during the 2016 academic session.
