


• The total response was 15 out of 71 teachers. A total of representative 14 departments responded out of 16 departments.








## • More than 40% agree that the course/syllabus has a good balance between theory and application.










• The response as to the marks allotment as per syllabus content is good.






• Greater positive response with regard to the restrooms facilty.




• Maximum responses agree that classrooms are teacher/learner friendly






Most agree that Library caters to their needs




#### • Neutral response to canteen facilities




## • Maximum responses are positive about lighting, seats, teaching aid like lecterns, board and ICT facility.




#### Positive response regarding the internal assessment



The syllabus provides freedom to modify and incorporate new topics in the syllabus






#### Most are positive that they have the freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching.

I have the freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching such as seminar presentations, group discussion and learners' participation






#### • Most agree that they have freedom to assess students in term of strategy.





The college had a friendly ambiance for teaching and learning






### More tha 50% agree that the college encourages faculty attending development programmes


