REPORT OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

The Alumni Feedback Analysis Report has been prepared on the basis of responses received from the Alumni. The responses have been gathered through an online Google form questionnaire sent to the alumni through available network of contacts and collected during May-June, 2024. It was an encouraging number of responses received from 77 alumni which is about three times of last year assessment. Hence, collected data holds reasonable confidence and fact about the college.

FEEDBACK OF SURVEY PARTICIPANTS

We received responses from those alumni who passed out from the college as old as from 1987 to recent 2023. The age of oldest alumni found in this feedback survey was 59 years.

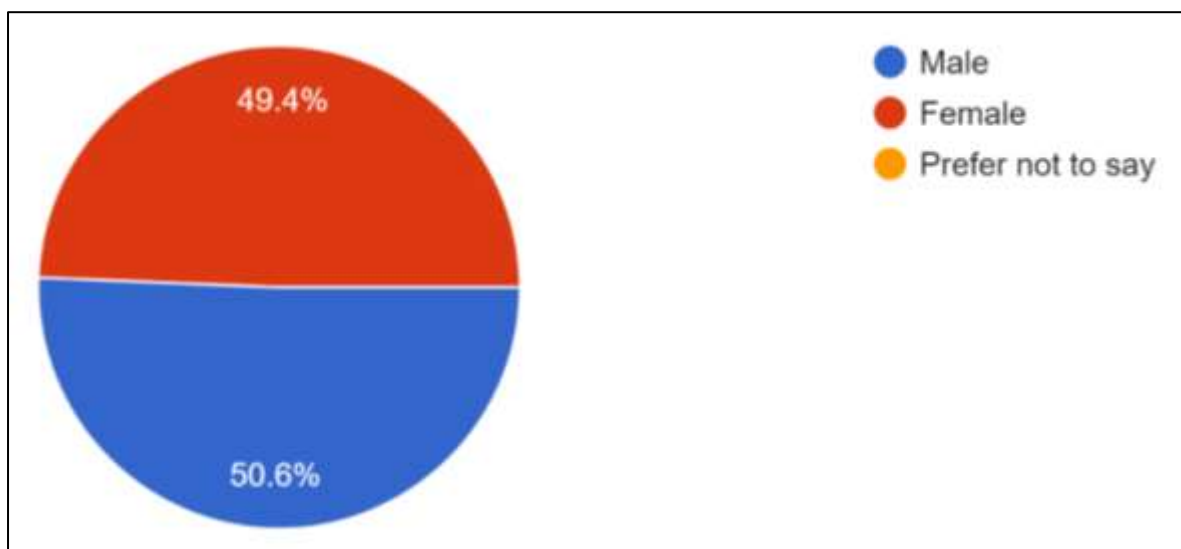


Figure 1: Gender equality of survey participants

It was an equal participation from the male and female alumni (Fig: 1).



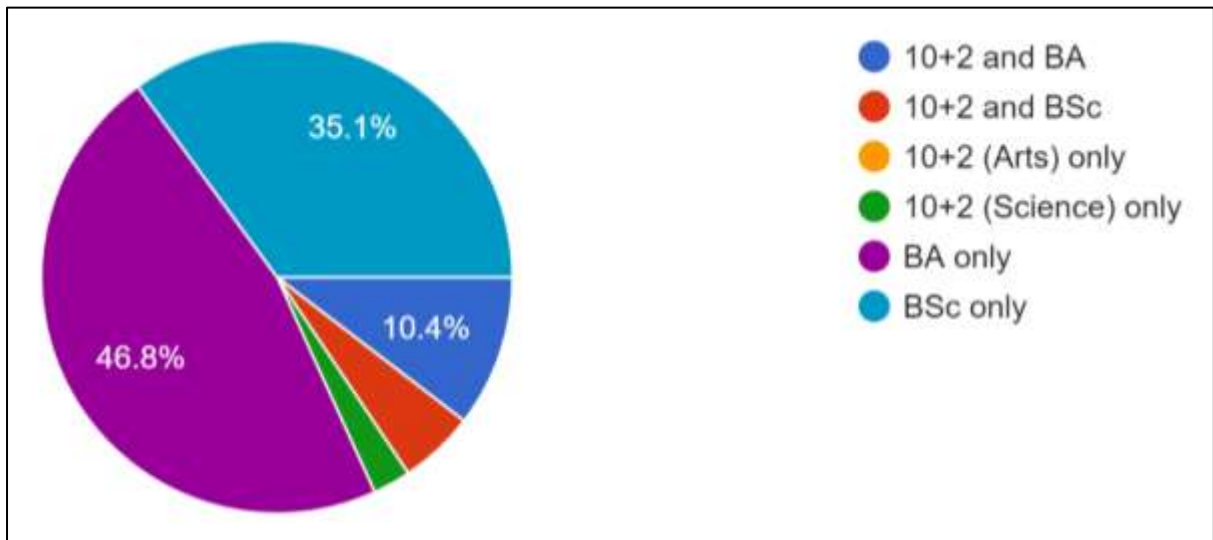


Figure 2: Courses studied in the college by the respondents

About 47% participants from degree arts followed about 35% by degree Science (fig: 2). Some alumni studied up to 10+2 (Arts or Science) level only, though presently college not having that stage.

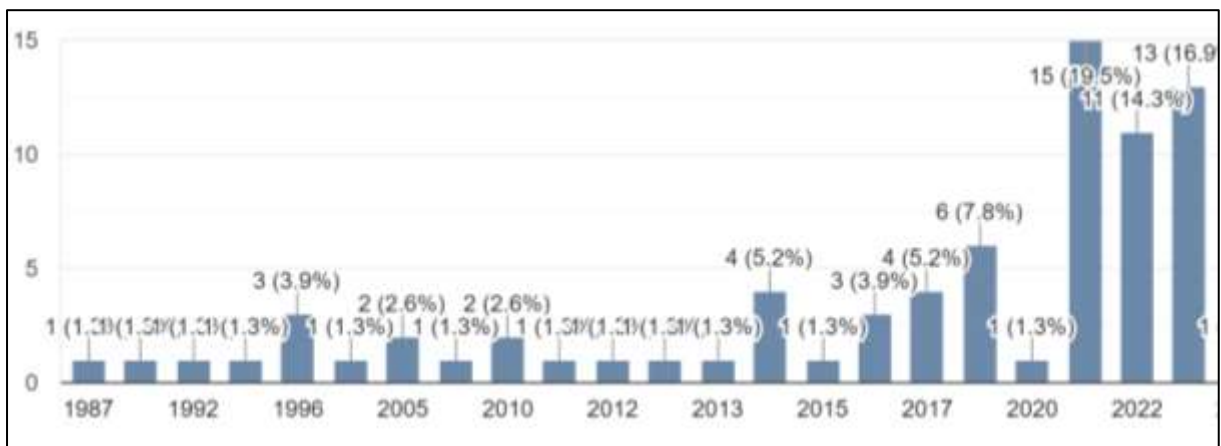


Figure 3: Passing year batches of the participants

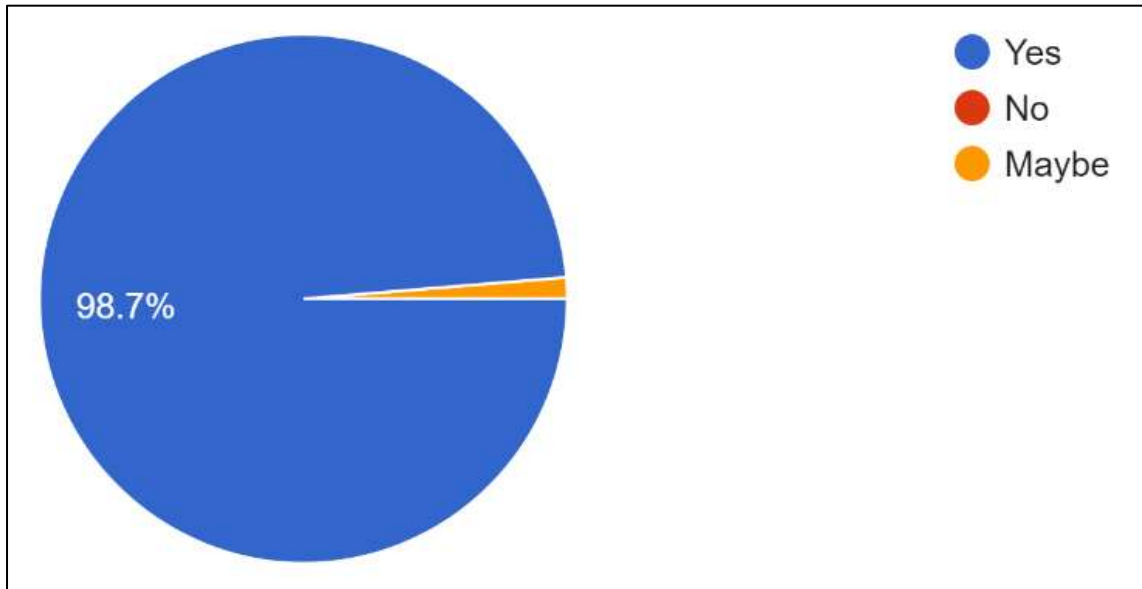


Figure 4: Do you feel proud to be associated with FAC as an alumnus/alumna?

There are about 99% participants, who expressed feel proud to be associated with the college (fig: 4). This reflects that the college is placed as a socially high and prestigious institution in the state.

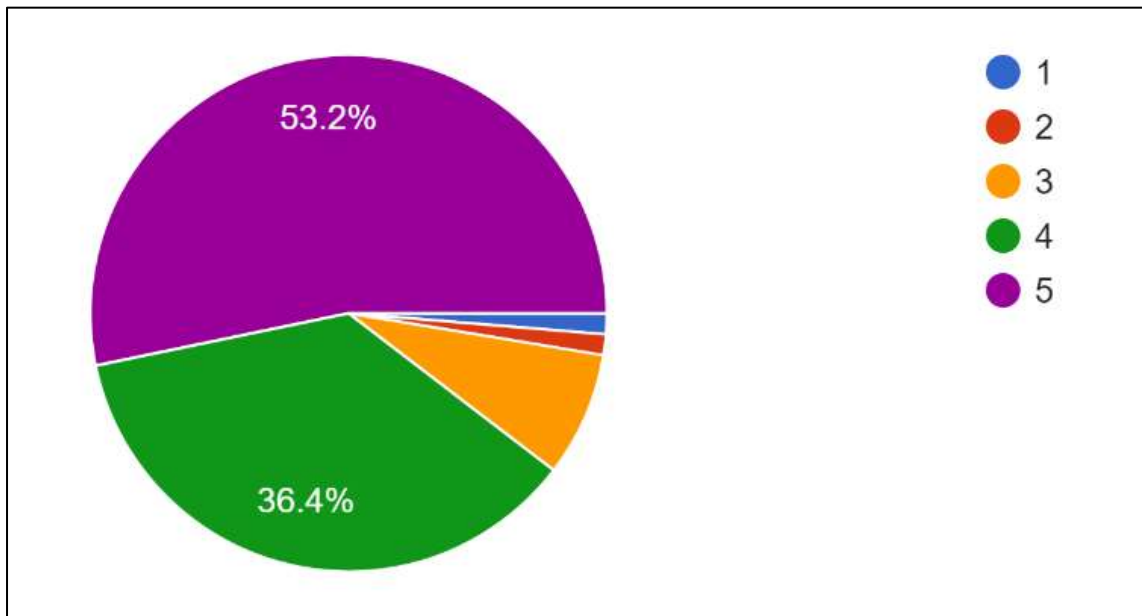


Figure 5: How would you rate your overall experience in the College? Please select your ratings on the scale 1 to 5.

The overall experience during their college life was good as 53% expressed highest score 5 followed by 36% score 4 (fig: 5). Thus, we can consider fulfilling their expectations.



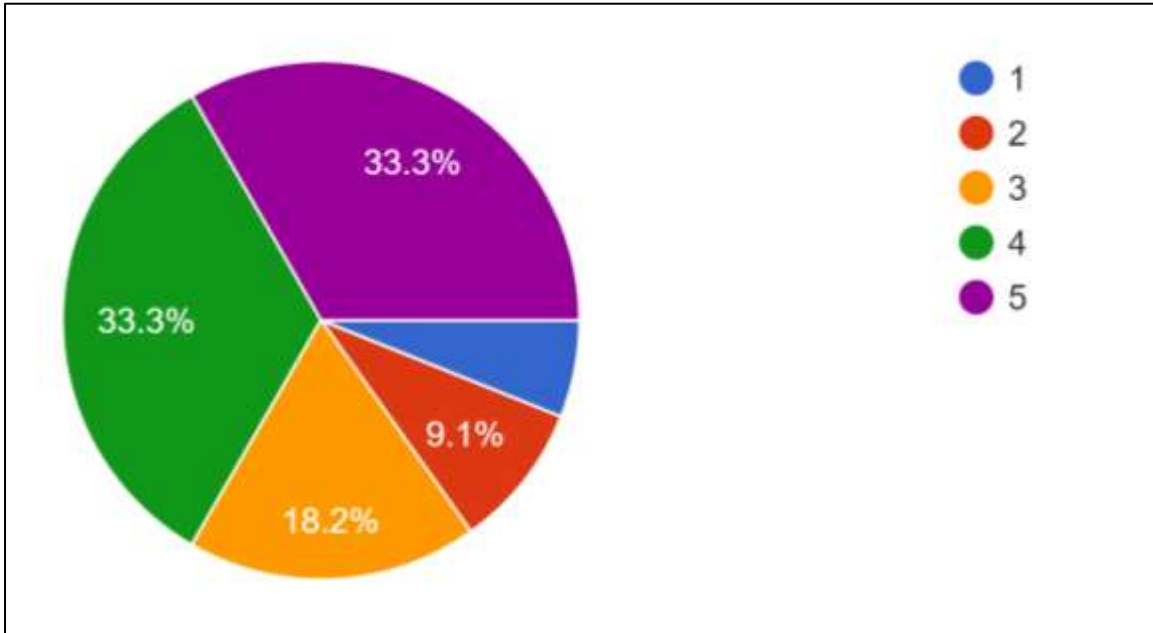


Figure 6: Did you stay in college hostel? If so, how do you rate the hostel facilities? Higher the score better the perception / experience.

Students who availed college hostel had some mixed experience (fig: 6). We should give more attention in their accommodation facilities.

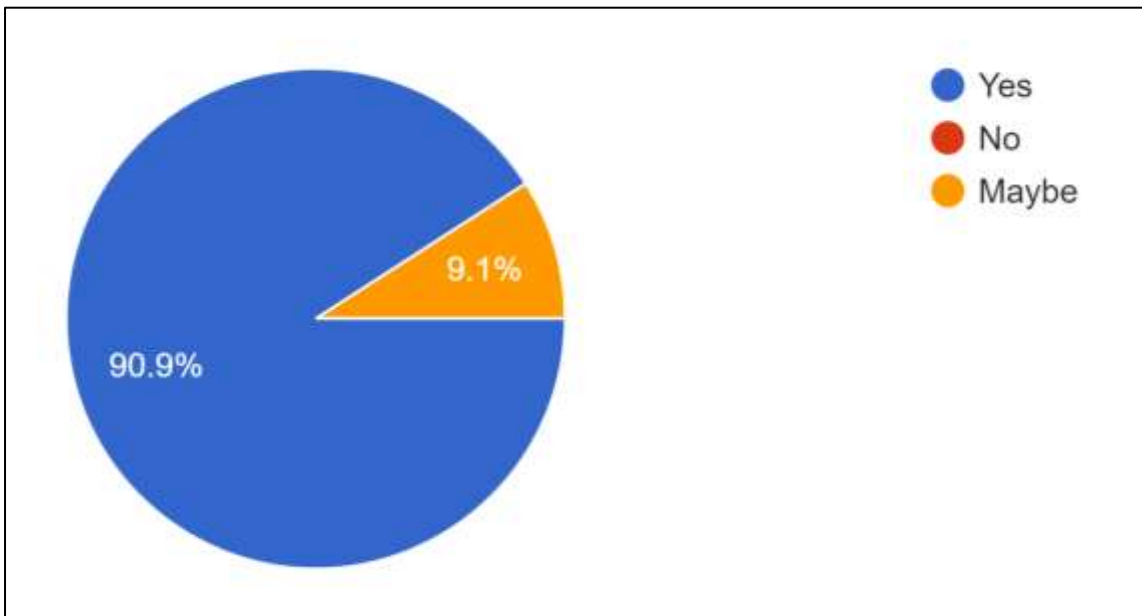


Figure 7: Will you recommend your relative/friends to enrol at FAC?

Based on experiences of the participants, about 91% are willing to recommend others to study in this college (fig: 7).



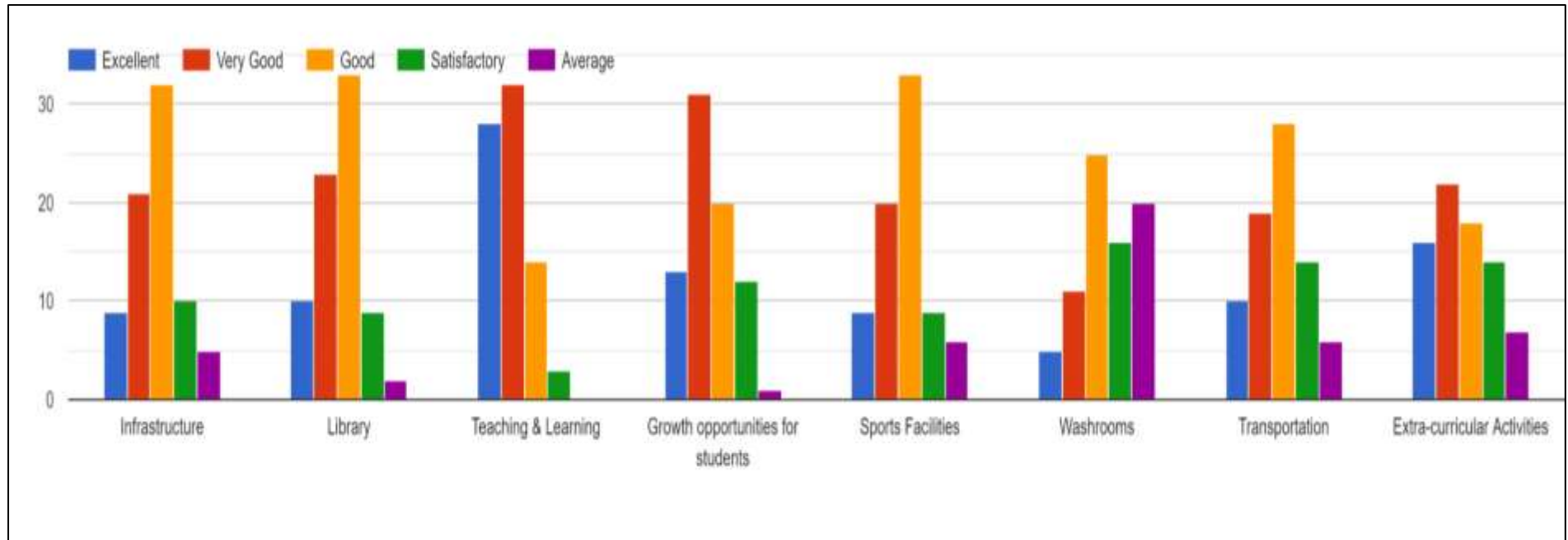


Figure 8: Please rate the following areas of the College as per your opinion.

It is reflected from figure 8 that the college scores highest in the teaching learning process. Also, students consider the college as a place of growth opportunity. Though college infrastructure, library and Sports facilities scores good but showing more room for improvements. Extracurricular activities and transportation also demand attention. However, washroom facilities indicate lowest score.



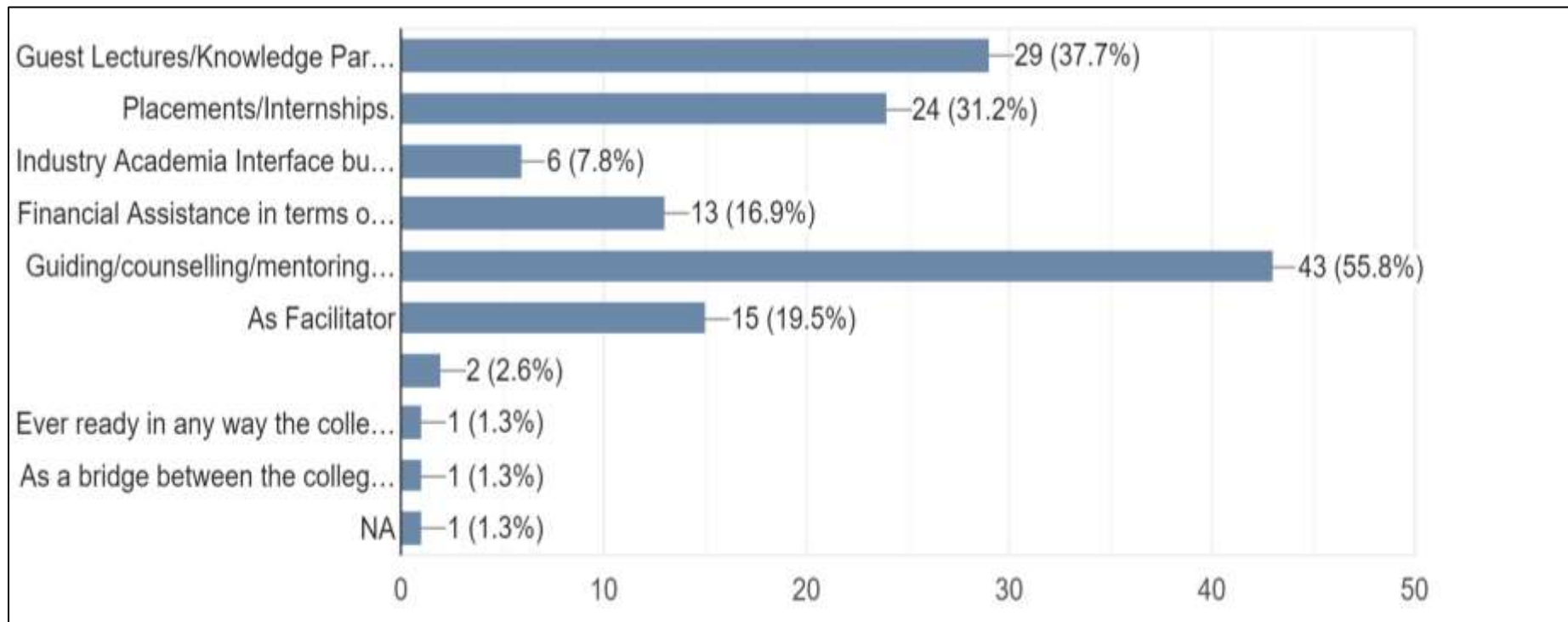


Figure 9: How would you like to contribute towards the development of the College?

The survey indicates positive attitude among the alumni towards the college (fig: 9). About 56% participants are willing to guide the college by way of mentoring or counselling. Also, about 38% respondents willing to impart in partnering knowledge. About 31% are interested in placements of the students followed by about 20% willing to play role of facilitator. Even about 17% are willing to provide financial assistance.

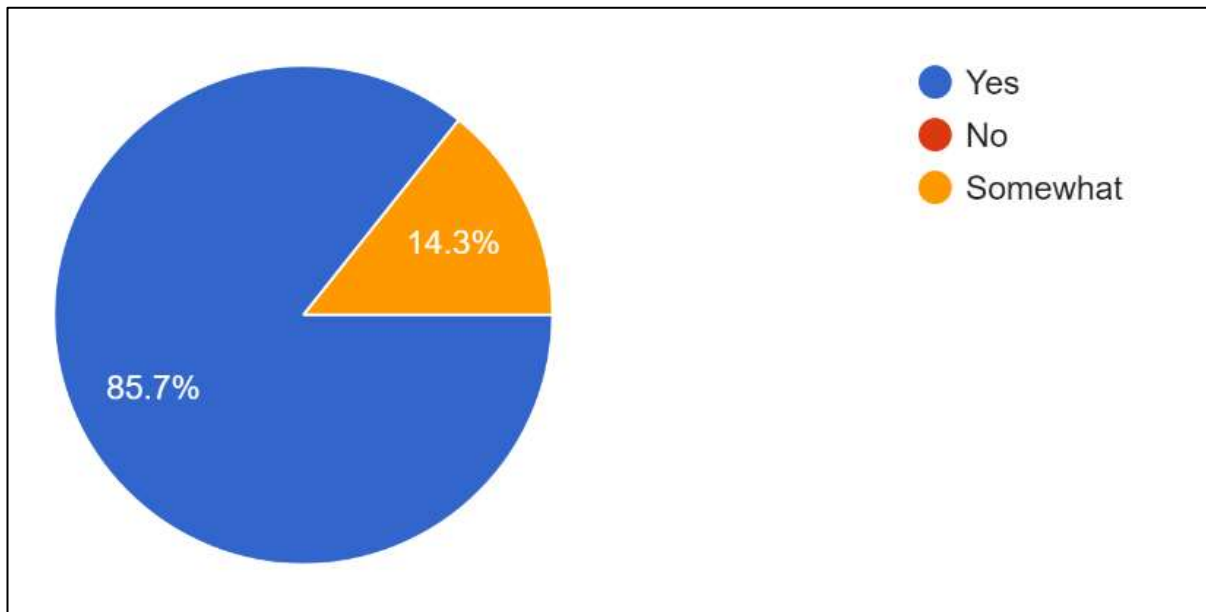


Figure 10: Are you satisfied with the efforts taken by the College to connect with its Alumni?

What efforts should the college take to integrate its alumni in further enhancing the overall quality of the Institution? - Responses:

To expand the areas of membership including former Fazlians from Eastern Areas too; organizing reunion program; To organize and programs at least once in a year for alumni; Organise alumni meets and function; Maybe Invite distinguished members from the Alumni to share their experience in the college and their journey after that; Improving connections among alumni, providing networking opportunities, organizing reunions/ Alumni events, and promoting a sense of community among graduates; Meeting regularly; Alumni regular membership and at least half yearly alumni interaction and feedback meetings can contribute something to strengthen the overall quality of our institutions; Continue engaging the Alumni in various occasions; It will be good to have an open invitation to come and help in the college in every possible areas as an intern or assisting in any kind of work; By providing opportunities to connect with each other through career fairs, professional development workshops or alumni panels; 1. Enhance Alumni Feedback Mechanism: Create a platform for alumni to provide feedback on their college experience, "curriculum", and suggestions for improvement, ensuring continuous enhancement. 2. Alumni Volunteer Opportunities: Provide opportunities for alumni to volunteer as guest speakers, mentors, or advisors for student clubs and organizations 3. Career Networking Events: Organize networking events where alumni and current students can connect, share job opportunities, and build professional relationships; Maybe get them to engage or attend social events; Should coordinate with all Alumni across all over the states and beyond and everyone should support in all possible means to enhance the quality of the institution; By reaching out through smart media and collecting suggestions; Invite the alumni in any occasion; Organize regular meet so that we can stay in touch with each other; To integrate alumni and enhance the institution's quality, colleges could establish mentorship programs, involve alumni in guest lectures or workshops, create networking events, seek alumni donations for specific projects or scholarships, and maintain active communication through newsletters or social media groups; Engaging alumni as partners can bring valuable insights, resources, and support to the institution; Seminars and internship; Thinktank communications with the alumni; Lessen festive events and give more importance to education by not trying to follow every modern trend or practice; Organize workshops or seminar kind of events with alumni involved; The college authority should collect each and every contact details and to form a group of the alumni's so that everyone will be able to gather together in the future; Host Alumni meet; Create a list of Alumni from college archive and collect contact details; Alumni gathering every 3



years; Involving them in career guidance and entrepreneurship seminar; Using alumni as role model for the upcoming graduate youths from FAC; Though we are many, if the college could try identify it's Alumni and organise some gathering/reunion in terms of 5 years patch, I think that will keep all of us connected; Maximum contribution to the college in all possible ways by the alumni is required in order to enhance the overall quality of the institution; The college authority should involve all alumni to contribute their valuable services to uplift the college at all times; The college is moving in the right direction regarding the efforts. Certain programs that can accommodate the alumni should be initiated and a common portal for all the alumni should be started so that every Fazlian can contribute to the growth of the FAC family; By reaching out to the alumni and engaging with them for discussing ideas and innovation for upliftment of the college; Providing placements maybe; Create an Instagram page for alumni; Invite those Alumni who excels in their profession to share their experience, achievement and encourage each other and contribute to enhance the quality of the institution. Some suggestions by alumni for improvement of college:

To have more teaching faculty for the students; Should improve in sports facilities; Improvement for sanitary toilets and washrooms; Increase the number of buses; Scholarship program for some students who are really struggling for their fees, books, uniforms or any financial problems can be screened by the authority and we fund a program and help the students in every possible ways; Communication and building close relationship with the students; Focus more in wholistic development of the students; Should give more importance in skill development; A strong and active mentorship from faculties; There is scarcity of water in the college so my suggestions is to look into this matter; Personalized Outreach: Tailor communication to alumni based on their interests and expertise, fostering a sense of connection and relevance; Regular Feedback Mechanism: Establish channels for alumni to provide feedback on their college experience and suggest areas for improvement; Alumni Recognition Programs: Acknowledge and celebrate the achievements of alumni, inspiring current students and fostering a culture of excellence; Professional Development Opportunities: Offer career advancement workshops, networking events, and job placement assistance to alumni, ensuring lifelong learning and growth; Collaborative Projects: Encourage alumni to collaborate on research, innovation, or community outreach initiatives, leveraging their diverse skills and experiences; Legacy Building Initiatives: Provide opportunities for alumni to leave a lasting impact on the institution through endowments, named scholarships, or infrastructure projects;

Digital Platforms: Create an online portal or app for alumni to stay connected, access resources, and participate in virtual events, overcoming geographical barriers; Alumni-Student Mentorship: Facilitate mentorship programs where alumni can guide and support current students, fostering a culture of mentorship and knowledge sharing; Strategic Partnerships: Forge partnerships with alumni associations, corporate sponsors, and other institutions to amplify the impact of alumni engagement efforts; Continuous Evaluation: Regularly assess the effectiveness of alumni integration initiatives and adapt strategies based on feedback and changing needs; Washroom and smart class probably; New and better lab equipment; With the regular degree courses, if we could introduce a full time or part of an elective subjects courses for coaching facilities for competitive examinations, so that once the students left the college he/she should be well informed and enlightened do adapt skilfully with the competitive exams; To have more practical lesson for the students in learning apart from classroom lectures; Get to know the struggles of students without generalising everything because of a small group observation; Focus more on education pertaining to teaching and practical rather than festive events; Providing proper information clearly, concisely and to the point to the alumni of the college; Provide proper water supply and more hygienic toilets; Provide more books as per the course; Apart from other infrastructure facilities, I think the college should also focus on having a good washroom especially for women; Should give importance on the washrooms for the students and water facilities as well; More books in the library, more equipment in lab; Emphasis on quality education; Going with the changing trend, if college can promote music and sports too, it will be a great launchpad for the youths; Infrastructure development, Evaluation teaching and learning environment; More opportunity for the science students and increase advertisement to attract science students enrolment, increase hostel facility; Elect the right leader irrespective of their tribe and background and give equal platform without any discrimination; For quality construction of any project in the college, land owner should allow reputed contractors to initiate and do the work; More skilled oriented courses solely by the institution or in collaboration with expert firm/ company should be initiated; Should have a fully automated e-library; More efforts should be given for the upliftment of the hostellers with regard to sound environment, hygienic mess and strict surveillance and monitoring of study hours; Invest in the infrastructure for the betterment of the college in days to come; Proper sports facilities is also the need of the hour; To introduce skill development courses; To upgrade the college to PG college; To introduce Commerce stream; To upgrade the library (digitized for issuing of books); To publish journals which are recognize under ugc care list/Scopus; Sponsorship programs; Campus placement; Civil service exam coaching; Enhancing the science department a little more by providing good and advanced equipment for practical; More focus on Infrastructure; Since the world is progressing in every field, college students should keep



their studies and prospective for national and international level; Unless the students are prepared for a wide & variety of knowledge, to perform in multiple areas, the reality of lifelong career is quite challenging; We must try to let students focus on professional courses; Quality education not the quantity education; Better infrastructure and lab facilities; Proper washroom and toilets for the students.

CONCLUSION

From the above analysis, we may gather the following:

1. The overall satisfaction level of the Alumni is good specially teaching-learning process.
2. Most alumni are found proud to be associated with the college and willing to actively help the college in their individual capacity. From the suggestions given by the alumni, we can assume that though college is doing good but there are room for improvements in the areas of sanitation, water, transportation and sports.
3. The alumni expressing willingness to engage in the college activities also. The college needs to make more efforts in utilizing their knowledge and services.

1. The Internal Alumni Committee set up in the college acts as the liaison between the institution and the Alumni Association to keep the alumni abreast with the various programmes of the college.
