ACTION TAKEN REPORT AY 2024-25

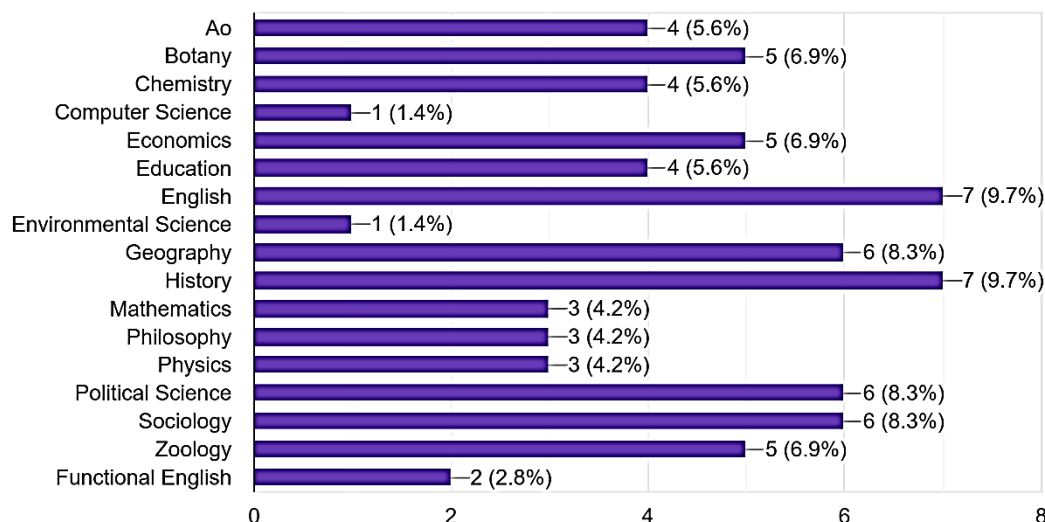

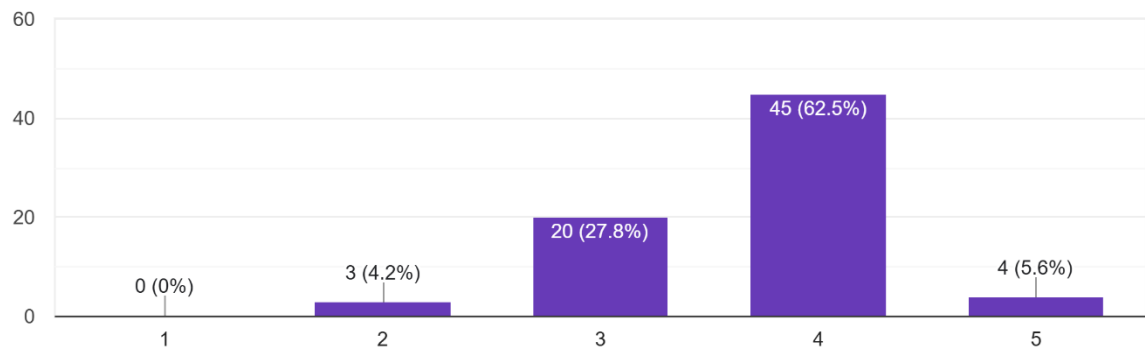

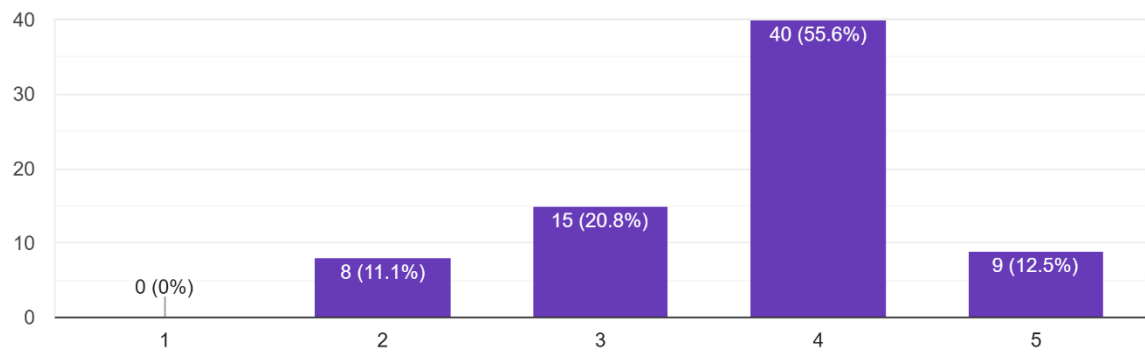
Present Syllabus is suitable for the course

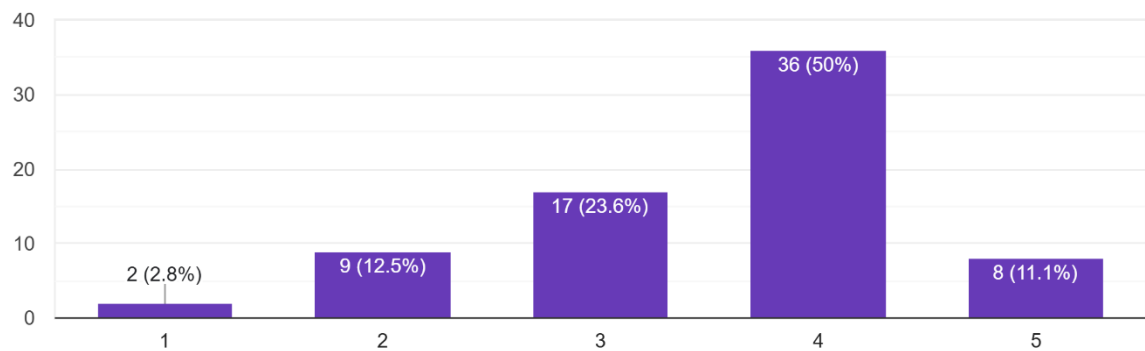
Syllabus is student centric

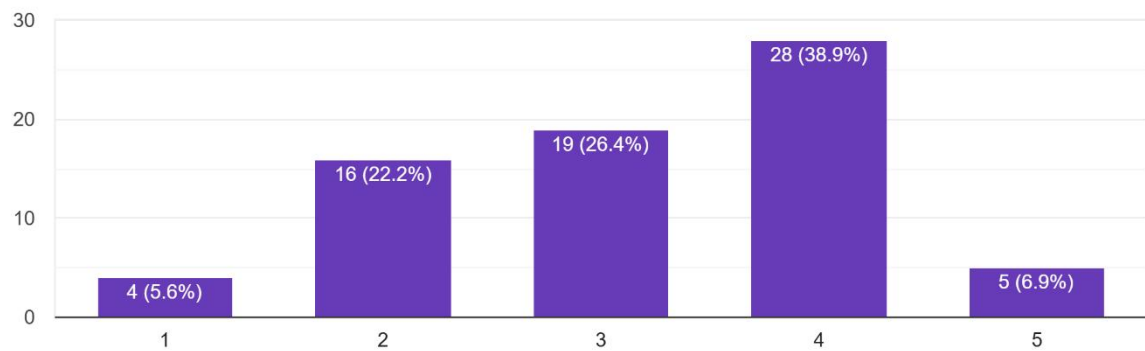
Aims and objectives of the syllabus are well defined and clear to teachers and students.

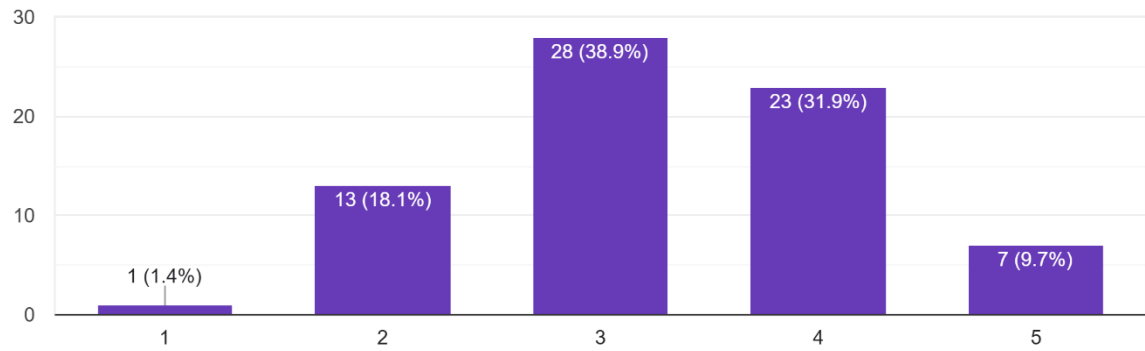
Course content are systematically distributed

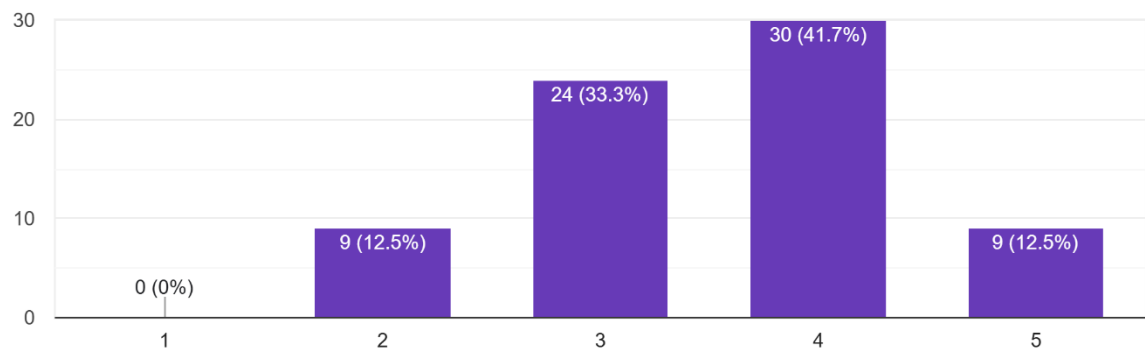

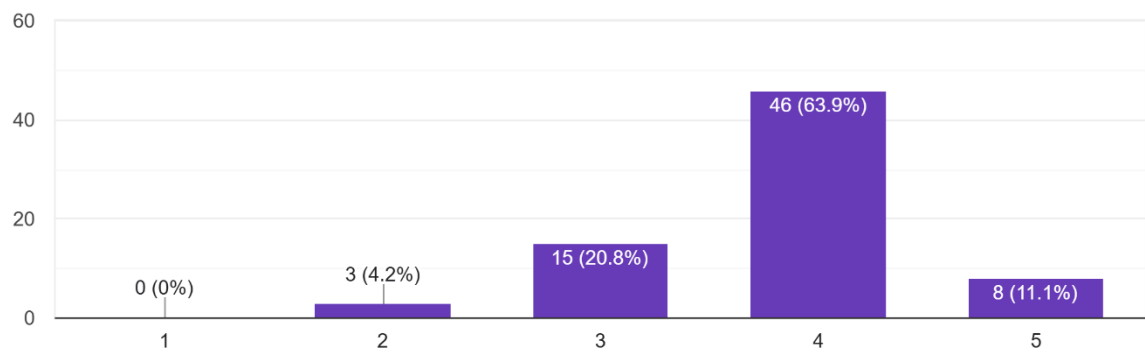
The course/syllabus has good balance between theory and application.

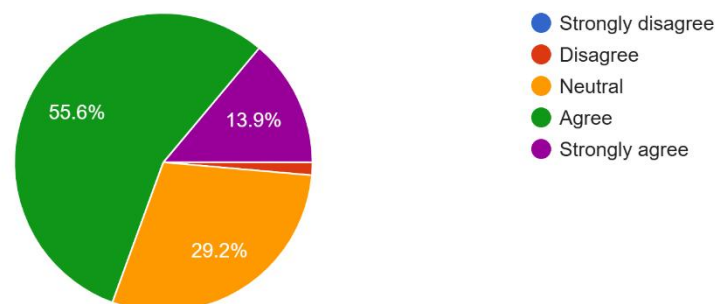
The course syllabus of the subject increased my knowledge and perspective in the subject area

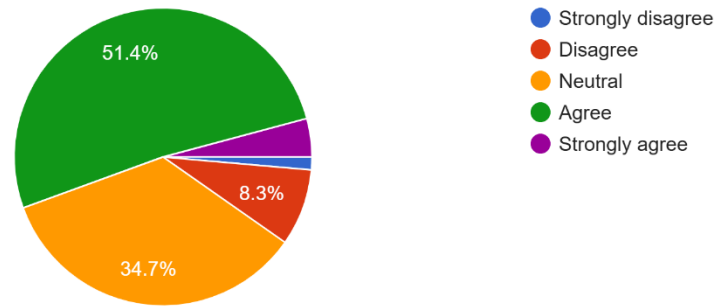

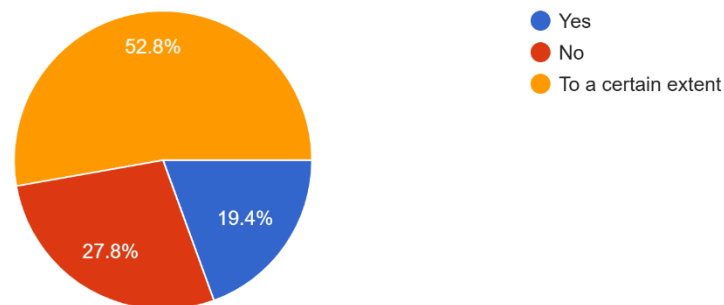

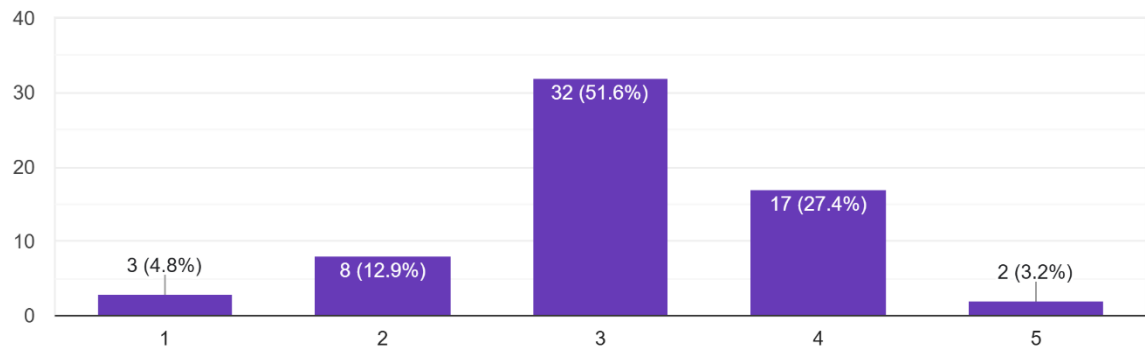

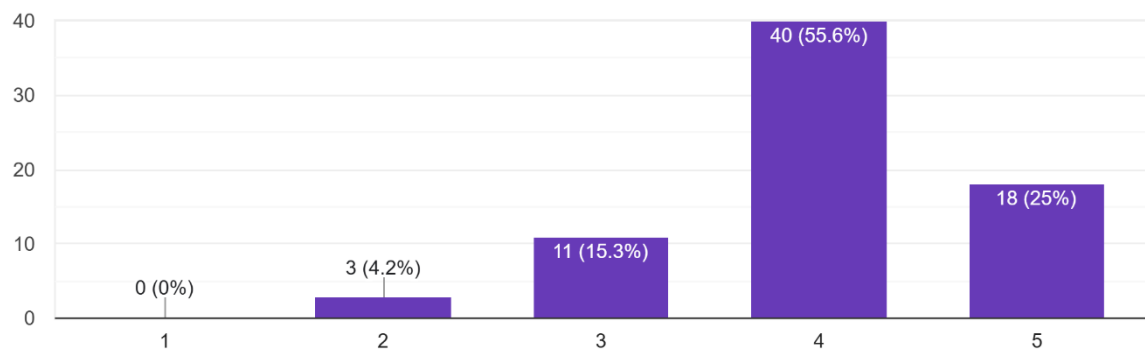
How satisfied are you with the laboratory facilities?

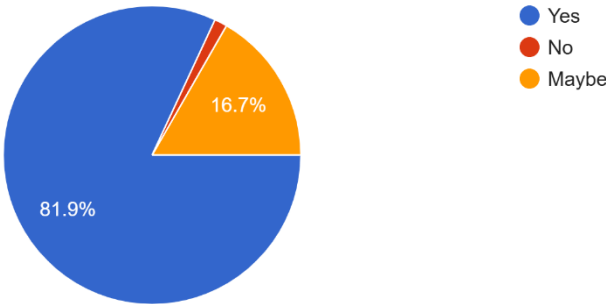
How satisfied are you with ICT facilities in the classrooms?

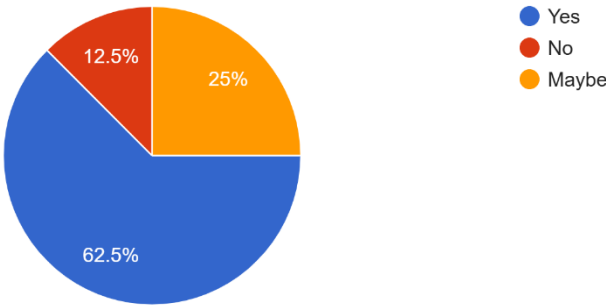

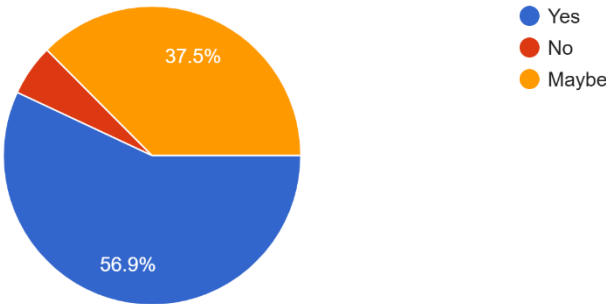
Lighting, seats, teaching aid like lecterns, boards and ICT facility in the classroom are sufficient

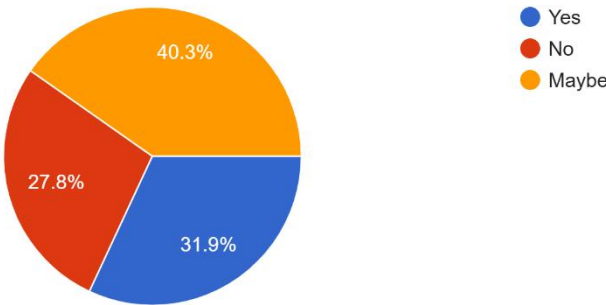
Library caters to your needs

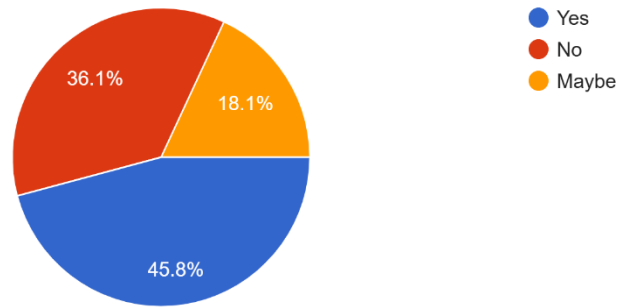
Canteen services are efficient

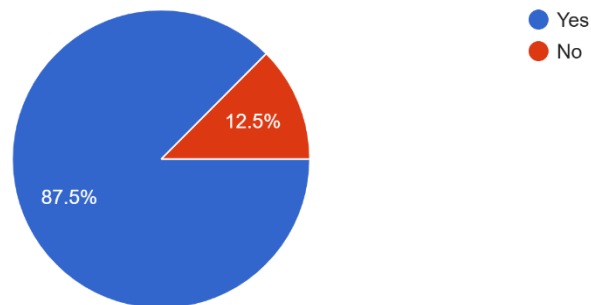
Restrooms for faculty are sufficient

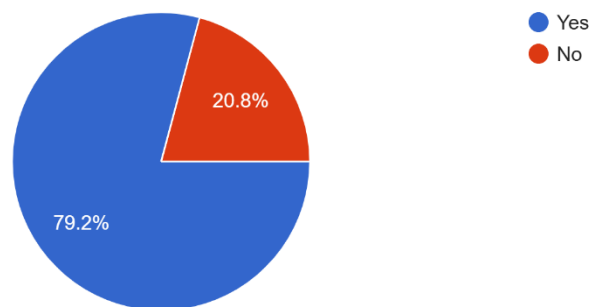

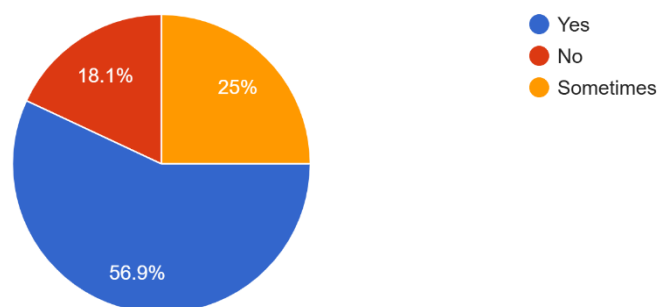
The course can be easily covered during the semester

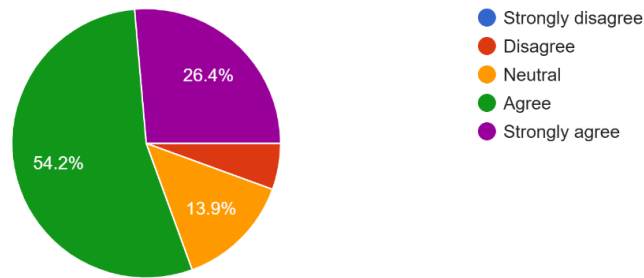

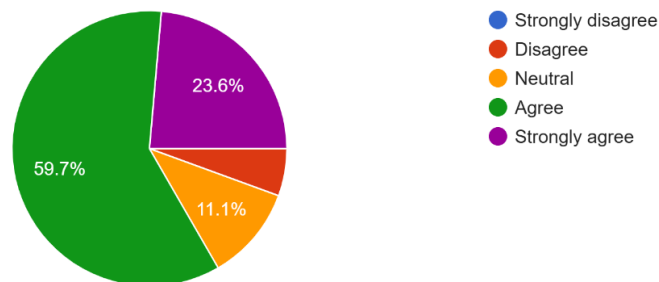

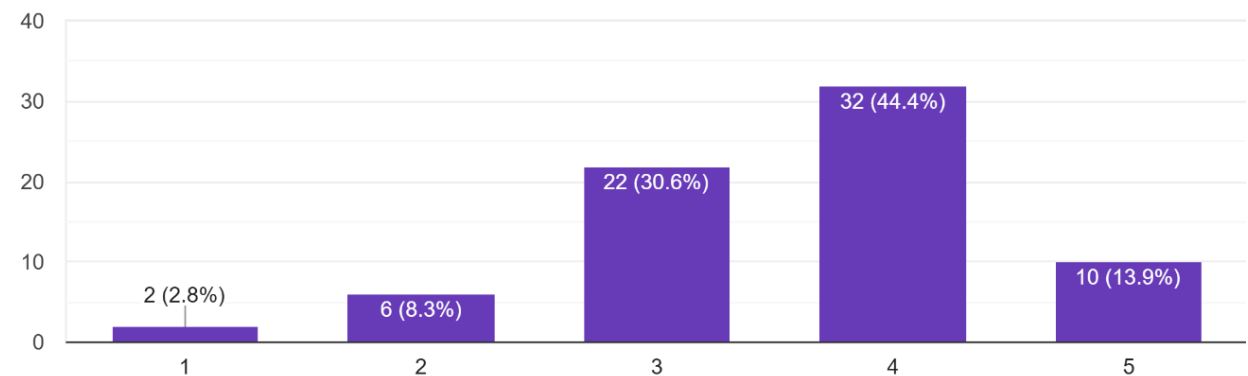
The environment in the department is conducive to teaching and research

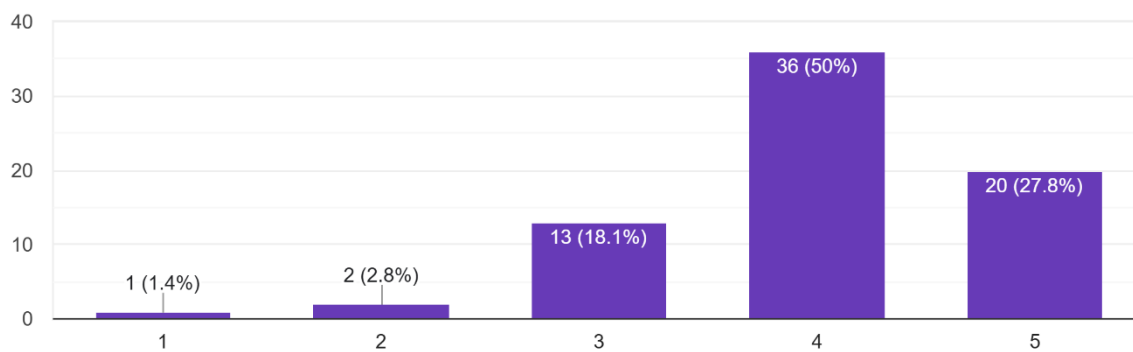
The college promote and provide scope for projects and research facility

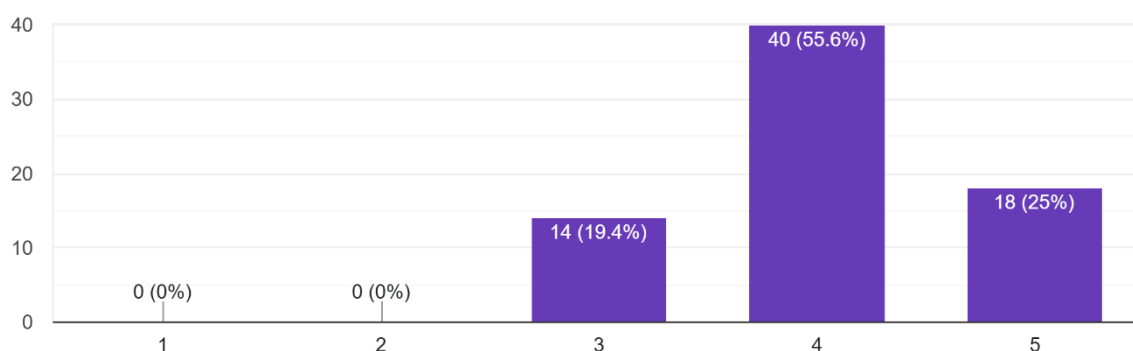
The College encourages and provides scope for attending faculty development programs

Action Taken:


