Notification

In continuation of the College Office notification with regards to the resumption of physical offline class from 7th October, 2021 in phase wise manner, the students are hereby informed to strictly adhere to all Generic Preventive Measures/COVID appropriate behavior put in place by the District Task Force (DTF) within the college campus and hostels.

1. The students should be fully vaccinated (taken both the doses) against COVID-19, or should have taken 1st dose of vaccine against COVID-19 and at least 15 (fifteen) days have passed since taking the 1st (first) dose .
2. Students who have been vaccinated either with both the doses and single dose are to submit a copy of the vaccination certificate to the authority.
3. Those students, who have not taken any dose of vaccine against COVID-19, are required to undergo testing every 15 (fifteen) days for COVID-19 through either RT-PCR or TrueNat or CBNAAT on self-payment basis and make available the negative COVID-19 test report to the FAC COVID-19 Task Force.
4. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible.
5. Use of face covers or masks is mandatory.
6. Frequent hand wash with soap (for at least 40 to 60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty should be encouraged.
7. Students are advised to bring their own alcohol based hand sanitizers and are requested to use whenever feasible.
8. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/ handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
9. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest to the authority.
10. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
11. Installation and use of Aarogya Setu app shall be advised wherever feasible.
12. In addition to all of the above, students who have not taken any dose of vaccine against COVID-19, and if they are 18 years of age and above are advised to get vaccinated at the earliest.
13. For any COVID-19 related emergency cases and queries, students are to contact the Fazl Ali College COVID-19 task force.
