It is the oldest College in Nagaland and is a co-educational Government College affiliated to Nagaland University. Located in idyllic sylvan settings, the College is about 5 kilometers from Mokokchung town.

The College was a private institution until 1962, when it was taken over by the Government of Nagaland. Initially it started with only the Arts stream. Subsequently Science stream was introduced in 1983 and the Commerce stream was introduced in 2025. Today, the College has grown to seventeen departments in Arts, Commerce and Science disciplines.

The objective of the College is to promote higher learning and to produce students who are second to none in academic quality. The College aspires to shape young minds and guide them in the development of their inherent skills and talents.

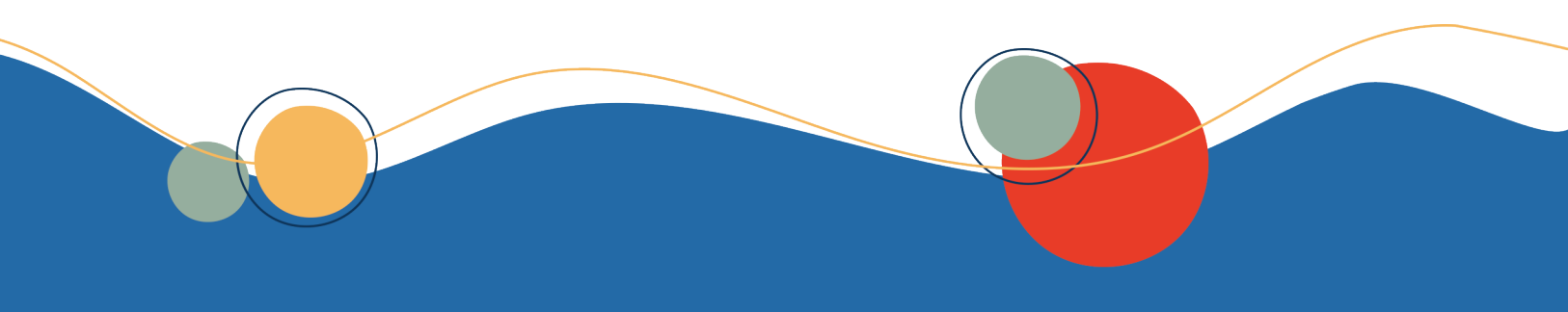
- To mould students to face the challenges of contemporary society and to possess definite target goals so that they can act as catalyst for socio-economic change.

## Admission

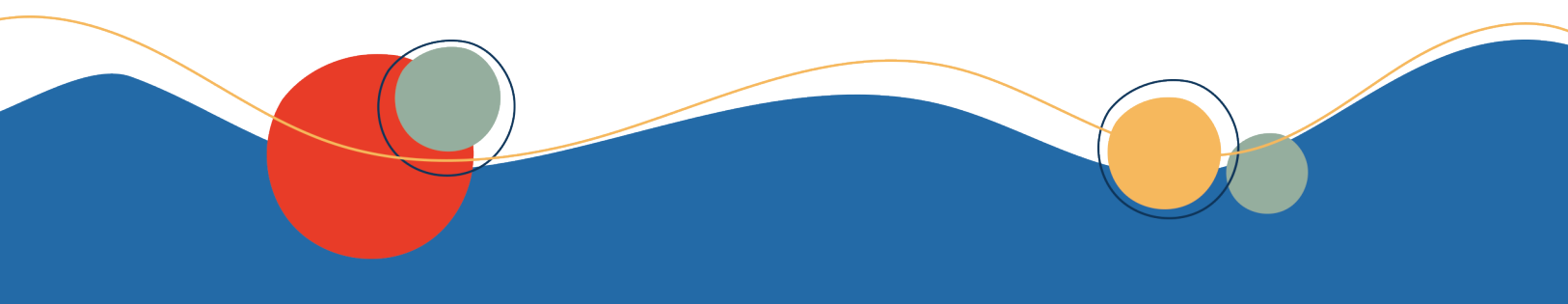
1. Admission to the College begins after the declaration of the HSSLC results. The Office will notify the date of admission.
2. Application forms can be obtained from the Office of the Principal/ College website (fac.ac.in).
3. During submission of Application forms, the following documents will be required for the admission process:
  - (a) Mark sheet of previous examination passed (HSSLC).
  - (b) Admit Card(s) of HSLC & HSSLC examinations.
  - (c) Aadhaar Card (Photocopy).
  - (d) Three recent photos of the applicant wearing light colored shirt/top. Students with long hair may neatly tie their hair back. The ears should be clearly visible in the photo. Photograph in school uniform will not be accepted.
  - (e) Students awaiting result of the qualifying exam can also apply for admission.
  - (f) Duly-completed application form accompanied by the necessary documents must be submitted on or before the last date as may be notified by the Principal.
  - (g) Application form not supported by all the above mentioned documents will be rejected.
  - (h) Original documents to be produced for verification as and when intimated by College authority.
4. Students from other Boards/Universities are required to produce Migration Certificate and Eligibility Certificate within one month of taking provisional admission.
5. Selection criteria: Admission to B.A/B.Sc/B.Com classes will be on the basis of the marks obtained in the HSSLC examinations.
6. Reservation for BA, B.Sc and B.Com:
  - Students with disabilities (PWD) are provided with 3% reservations.
  - The college has inadequate facilities for PWD students. As a result, this alternative will be considered following a case-by-case analysis of the nature of the impairment.
  - All claims should be supported by relevant documents.
  - In case of non- availability of candidates from the reserved categories, seats will be de-reserved and filled by others from non-reserved categories.

## Eligibility for Admission

1. For admission into BA/B.Com/B.Sc Honours, a minimum of 45% marks in the subject for which Honours is sought, in the qualifying exam at the 10+2 level
2. Students opting for Honours in those subjects not offered at Class 12 level should have scored a minimum of 45% in the aggregate
3. Shifting from other streams (Science/Commerce) to Arts stream is allowed provided they have secured 45% in the aggregate in the qualifying exam. Admission is on the basis of merit.

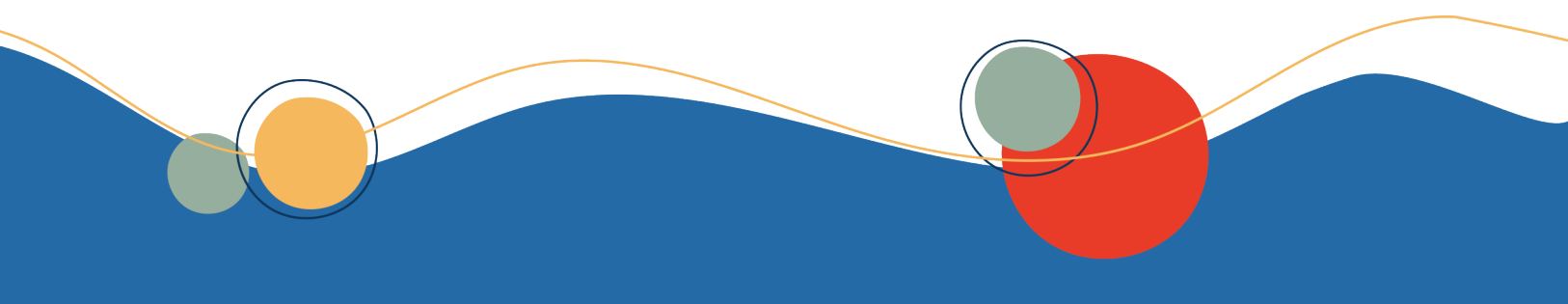

- Minor subject should be related to Major Subject

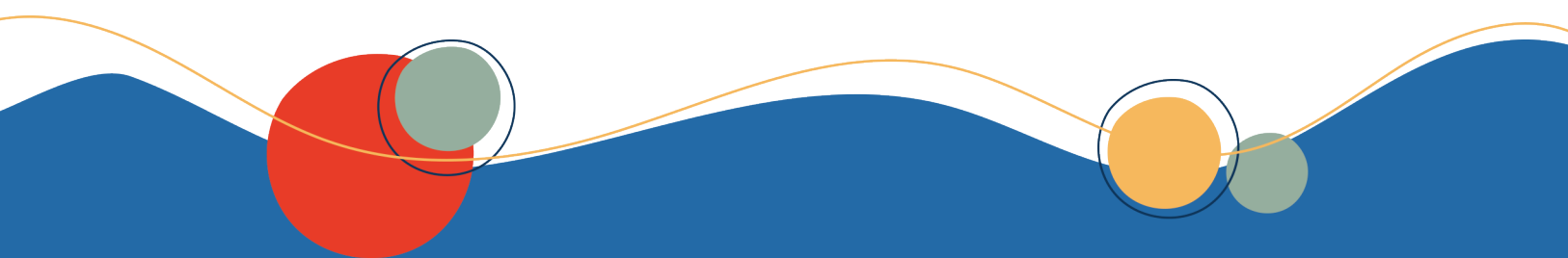
